## DID YOU KNOW?

### ACWD HAS THREE PRIMARY SOURCES OF WATER SUPPLY:

- 40% - Alameda Creek Watershed (local)
- 40% - State Water Project (imported)
- 20% - San Francisco Regional Water System (imported)

### WE STORE TODAY'S WATER FOR TOMORROW'S NEEDS:

ACWD has a diverse water supply and stores water during wet years to use in dry years. This approach helps ensure a more reliable supply, allowing us to meet our customers' needs even during droughts.

### ACWD HAS THREE TREATMENT FACILITIES:

- Water Treatment Plant Number 2
- Newark Desalination Facility
- Blending Facility

### OUR INFRASTRUCTURE KEEPS WATER FLOWING TO YOU:

Water is distributed to customers through 930 miles of pipelines and is stored in 13 storage tanks and reservoirs throughout the Tri-City area.
