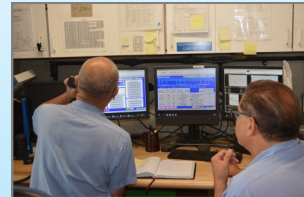
September is Emergency Preparedness Month

ACWD's Emergency Operation Center was activated as part of the drill, emergency equipment was tested, operational plans were refined, and communication was coordinated with Alameda County.
