

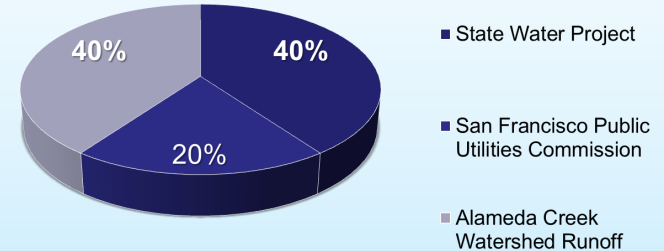
# THE ACWD CONNECTION

## January Rainfall Update

Winter is almost half over and we have seen a few regional storms. Although 2019's rainfall and snowpack are "less than average" for this time of year, ACWD's overall water supply is plentiful. Here is a snapshot of overall conditions:

- Local rainfall is 8.03 inches to date, which is 96 percent of average.
- Local groundwater conditions are healthy due to rainfall, recharge operations and the conservation efforts of our customers.
- Reservoirs around the state are near average for this time of year due to the snow pack from last winter.
- Cycles of very dry and very wet conditions are normal for California.
- Local drought risk is currently low due to the diversity of ACWD's water supply portfolio and, again, the conservation efforts of our customers.
